

In the month of September 2017, AVI-OIL India (P) Ltd. joined hands with SMILE Foundation to support a Mission Education (ME) centre in Ballabhgarh, Faridabad with Mission Education implementing CBO partner 'Prayas Social welfare Society'-a non-profit, service organization registered under Haryana Registration and regulation of Societies Act, 2012.
